

Outing Risk Guidelines

All residents planning to go out of the facility for any purpose other than a medical appointment must provide details of outing to Administrator or Director of Resident Services at least 48-72 hours prior to event. A risk assessment will be completed and a plan for additional precautions will be developed and reviewed with resident. Education will be provided, and the assessment must be signed by the resident prior to going out of the facility. Listed below are some examples of outings with possible risk associated. This list is not all inclusive, these are used for guidance only, each outing will be assessed individually based upon information provided and the risk level may be adjusted.

Residents are required to notify staff if the original plan was changed or additional risks are identified. All residents will be assessed for symptoms upon return. Plans for additional monitoring may change based on the assessment upon return to facility.

Low Risk Activities: No additional precautions are needed

- Medical appointments with fully vaccinated individual
- Meal at home or indoor gathering with fully vaccinated individual(s) in small group <10
- Car ride with vaccinated individual(s)
- Attend small, outdoor gathering (10 people or fewer)

Moderate Risk Activities: Resident will be tested twice weekly for 14 days

- Attend medium sized gathering outdoors 10-50 people
- Visit barber or hair salon
- Attend medium indoor gathering of fully vaccinated 10-30
- Attend medium outdoor sporting events <50

High Risk Activities: Possible Quarantine for 14 days, dependent upon county positivity rate (CMS) where event is held, and details of outing

- If event is held in a county with moderate to high County Positivity Rate=quarantine
- If event is held in a county with low County Positivity Rate=Test twice weekly for 14 days
- Funeral
- Wedding
- Shopping
- Indoor event/party >30 people
- Eating at Restaurant
- Attend large outdoor sporting event >50 people
- Attend any indoor sporting event
- Residents out of the facility overnight and/or >24 hours

Mask use is ALWAYS encouraged for outings, particularly if contact with unvaccinated individuals is likely.
